Approved Seed List

Genetically modified organisms, non-native perennials and invasive annuals or perennials cannot be planted on our property.

Generally Acceptable Species

(includes the most common species, but is not limited to the list below)

- Clovers (most common species: arrowleaf , ladino, berseem, crimson, alsike, red)
- Annual or Elbon Rye (differs from rye grass, which is a perennial invasive)
- Wheat
- Oats
- Brown top millet (except foxtail millet)
- Milo (also called grain sorghum)
- Soybeans
- Cowpeas
- American jointvetch
- Corn
- Chicory
- Austrian Winter peas
- Lab Lab
- Kale, rape, turnips

Prohibited Species

(includes most common problem species on Soterra land food plots, but not limited to the list below)

- Perrenial Rye grass (annual rye only)
- Bahia grass
- Cogon grass
- Sericea lespedeza
